The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit SSAFA Forces Help will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request SSAFA Forces Help to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by SSAFA Forces Help or your bank or building society you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society
 - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when SSAFA Forces Help asks you to
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

GIFT AID DECLARATION

If you are a UK taxpayer and would like SSAFA Forces Help to reclaim tax on this donation, all donations you make hereafter until you notify you otherwise, please tick, sign and date below.

Please note: You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax in each tax year at least equal to the tax we will claim from HM Revenue and Customs on your Gift Aid donation(s).

We will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 05/04/2008 and 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 06/04/2008. The Government will pay SSAFA an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 06/04/2008 and 05/04/2011. This transitional relief to SSAFA does not affect your personal tax position. The tax reclaimed will be used to fund the whole of our work.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
