



SAMPLE CLAUSES

SSAFA recommends that you talk to a solicitor when making or updating your Will.

The following are some sample clauses to assist you when including SSAFA in your Will. You may wish to take them with you when you visit your solicitor.

RESIDUARY GIFT

If you would like to gift of all or part of your residue to SSAFA

I give to SSAFA, Queen Elizabeth House, 4 St Dunstons Hill, London EC3R 8AD*, with Registered Charity No. 210760 & SC038056 all the residue of my estate [or a share of the residue of my estate] for its general charitable purposes.

I declare that the receipt of the duly authorised officer of SSAFA shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my Executors/Trustees.

PECUNIARY GIFT

If you would like to make a gift of a specific amount of money to SSAFA

I give to SSAFA, Queen Elizabeth House, 4 St Dunstons Hill, London EC3R 8AD *, with Registered Charity No. 210760 & SC038056 the sum of £ for its general charitable purposes.

I declare that the receipt of the duly authorised officer of SSAFA shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my Executors/Trustees.

SPECIFIC GIFT

If you would like to gift a specific item which you own to SSAFA

I give to SSAFA, Queen Elizabeth House, 4 St Dunstons Hill, London EC3R 8AD *, with Registered Charity No. 210760 & SC038056 [a specific item]or its sale proceeds for its general charitable purposes.

I declare that the receipt of the duly authorised officer of SSAFA shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my Executors/Trustees.

***If you wish to leave a gift in your Will for the benefit of a specific SSAFA Branch or Division please use the address of SSAFA as above and add the following sentence to the clause: "...and I express the wish, that the said charity use the said bequest for [please include details of specific Branch, Division or area]."**
